AUSTRALIAN EMBASSY BANGKOK

BVN

The unique environments of Australia's agricultural, desert, coastal and urban realms inspired the conceptual foundations for the design of the new Australian Embassy in Bangkok. The design brief called for a sixty-year functional life, and the delivery of the building was undertaken with great care in construction, detailing and selection of materials.

Bricks were selected for their visceral expressionistic qualities, made bespoke by Bowral Bricks to match the original Thai brick, which has been the building block of Thai temples and public buildings for centuries. The colour also expresses the strong red oxide of Australian desert rocks, soil and sand. The three buildings of the embassy are built with different bricks, enabling scale, tactility and expression: for the chancery, Embassy Red; for the Head of Mission residence, roman-sized Bowral Blue; and for the services building and street edge, Brahman Granite.

LEARNING & TEACHING BUILDING MONASH UNIVERSITY - CLAYTON CAMPUS

JOHN WARDLE ARCHITECTS

The Learning and Teaching Building (LTB) for Monash University is a multi-faculty learning facility that serves a significant proportion of the student teaching load for the Clayton campus. Innovative formal learning and teaching spaces are complemented by informal learning hubs that deliver a variety of study settings. The interior forms and materiality reflect a blurring of interior and exterior spaces, and between building and campus. Streets, courtyards, bridges, balconies and stairs are transformed into ravines, clearings, strands, perches, nests and amphitheatres that are choreographed to make an interior landscape. The forms of the brick towers within the interior serve to frame spaces. They are also reminiscent of other brick structures. They share their tapering and curvilinear character with the pottery kilns of Stoke-on-Trent in England, for example. This reference to an industrial landscape suggests the process of firing, which starts with malleable clay and is abstractly akin to the process of learning. The custom extruded brick elements are striking visual markers that extend the materiality of the ground plane upward. They draw the eye toward the sawtooth roof and skylights above, while accommodating a range of formal and informal learning spaces inside.

CORNERSTONE STORES

RICHARDS & SPENCE

Located on the Gold Coast Highway in Tugun, Cornerstone Stores turns its attention away from the highway to the neighbouring creek and nature reserve, offering a cloistered courtyard and garden for local residents. With a strong sense of community, the family owners have collected a carefully curated mix of small local retailers, makers and service providers.

This project demonstrates careful planning and a nononsense aesthetic. The choice of red bricks references the local 1960s apartment building vernacular. Continuing inside and out, across walls, floors and arches, the brickwork provides a robust finish for people and plants, inviting the patina of time. Finely crafted details articulate the material qualities of the brickwork and direct shadows from the Queensland sun.

DAY STREET APARTMENTS

TZANNES

Day Street Apartments is both a bold new addition to the western wall of the Sydney CBD and a carefully crafted urban infill building that rejuvenates two very different street environments. The building is simultaneously grounded and floating, clad in a golden metal mesh that responds to the skyline of the city. Mowbray Blue bricks from the PGH Bricks and Pavers Dry Pressed collection were used. A solid-brick base is a sculpted yet singular element; its height, materiality and detail provide a contemporary reference to the brick warehouses the building replaces, and it serves to integrate the building with the formerly industrial context of Haymarket. Deep brick reveals reinforce the monumentality of this part of the building, while the texture of the brick provides a fine-grained level of detail. The podium's straight edge to Day Street reinforces the definition of the western edge of the city, while the building also follows the irregular geometry of the laneway, providing varied characters to each frontage. The tower above is warm and iridescent, designed around a system of folding gold-coloured screens. The tower reads as bold, large scale and singular, rich in texture and colour, continually dynamic and visibly responsive to the time of the day, sun and temperature conditions.

MAITLAND RIVERLINK

CHROFI

Maitland Riverlink is a project that evolved from a need to revitalise the town centre of Maitland, in the Lower Hunter Valley of New South Wales. It draws locals back to the Hunter River, which is fundamental to the town's heritage. The design team worked alongside the local council to find the right buildings to purchase and redevelop for this purpose, adding a new layer to the town centre experience. The choice of brick was critical to this vision. After various experiments, a more diverse-looking Petersen brick was chosen for the way it looks against modern architecture; it was important to use a brick that worked well with existing structures. The building needed to speak of its time but also be complementary to the old buildings in the street, which feature handmade bricks. Petersen bricks have an individual quality: every brick looks different, providing the interest, richness and texture required for the project. Maitland's old buildings are made from a combination of light blonde or creamy blonde bricks, and the Petersen D71 brick was a great match. Bullnose brick specials were also critical to achieving the building's impossibly sharp

HORBURY HUNT RESIDENTIA AWARD

This award was initiated by the Horbury Hunt Club and by request from architects and designers. Its purpose is to reward innovation and craftsmanship in brickwork and to recognise the contribution of architects, builders, bricklayers and manufacturers in that process.

The Horbury Hunt Residential Award category includes built residential projects that exemplify outstanding craftsmanship and innovation through the use of clay face brick and pavers. The award is named after John Horbury Hunt (1838-1904), a renowned architect who came to Australia from America in 1863. Hunt was known for introducing his distinctive and radical architecture to Sydney and rural New South Wales, including St Peter's Anglican Cathedral in Armidale, and Convent of the Sacred Heart and Tivoli in Rose Bay.

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
APARTMENT HOUSE

KERSTIN THOMPSON ARCHITECTS

Built around a courtyard and nestled within a garden setting, Apartment House is an elevated dwelling configured to safeguard views. The abundance of natural light is central to its long-term amenity. In this project, much delight comes from the views into and through the densely planted garden.

Apartment House continues an interest in the brick vernacular of suburban Melbourne and the capacity for masonry to be detailed as opaque wall or transparent screen. A white clay brick is the primary material for the exterior and interior walls. Contrasting with the chalky matte finish of this is the reflectivity of a glazed brick, in the same colour, used in wet areas and to form a datum line to the base of the exterior walls. Glass inserts within the vertical joints of the front facade filter the western sun. This brings a play of light – dazzling at times, aqueous at others – to the interior; its dynamism and changeability enliven the firmness of the rectilinear geometry of the plan and section.

MOUNT LAWLEY

WESTSTYLE DESIGN & DEVELOPMENT

This project was designed for a young modern family who love to entertain. The finishes are practical and low maintenance, with polished concrete, features of timber and brickwork that give the space a sense of warmth and character. The house is separated into two buildings that are connected by a gallery, with outlooks to the central courtyard and pool. The front building has a threedimensional facade, playing on the traditional childlike drawing of a house. With four equal walls and a tall triangular-shaped roof, the entire room is constructed from Austral Bricks Elements bricks in Zinc. This is an uncommon and tricky application, but striking in its execution. Sharp lines and rough textures externally are transformed into opulent finishes and soft curves on the interior, with gentle curving to the ceiling points and warm timber parquetry. A slick, lined window seat pushes through the wall to overlook the pool and draw in natural light. At the front is a full-width sliding entrance door, hidden by the feature patterned brick screening. This brick house glows from within and the light plays through the front brick screen, which also provides privacy to the room inside.

TIGER PRAWN

WOWOWA

Glorified in architecture forever, the humble tiger prawn becomes a two-pronged deity for this Fitzroy North renovation in Melbourne. The existing Victorian terrace's zigzagged (almost scalloped) brown and gold brick facade was translated and embellished to form the scalloped extension at the rear, whimsically drawing a fortified silhouette in the sky.

The brief called for the robustness, craft and ornament of the front to be mirrored in the back extension, in the spirit of cohesion and reinterpretation of the existing visual language. The weightiness of the bricks was critical in creating a sense of public generosity. Big-ticket items are the bricks and glazing. The home also packs a sustainability punch with insulated double-brick cavities, double glazing, cross-ventilation, thermal floor mass and a tidy footprint.

THREE CHIMNEY HOUSE

KP ARCHITECTS

The Three Chimney House is a single-storey dwelling located in the outer-eastern suburb of Chandler, about thirty minutes' drive from the Brisbane CBD. A shaped plan was chosen, forming a summer and a winter courtyard that allow outside views, drawing the landscaping in and around the house. The east and west wings establish high walls, further protecting these outdoor spaces, which feel like rooms. A small, detached studio is also situated within the winter courtyard. PGH Bricks and Pavers Velour brick in Crevole was selected for the building's exterior and interior walls, chosen for its robustness and ability to withstand Queensland's harsh weather conditions, as well as for its textural qualities. The smooth texture and consistent colour of the Crevole brick provides a shimmering effect in the sunlight and when illuminated at night. The brick is continued internally, blurring the line between the inside and outside. Three chimneys, as the name suggests, are aligned on the north-south axis, grounding the building and anchoring the house to its site. Sculptural folding roofs reach for the sky, funnelling natural light into the home and framing the views to the outside.

ITALIANATE HOUSE

RENATO D'ETTORRE ARCHITECTS

This project involved the restoration and modification of a heritage-listed, three-storey Italianate-style terrace house and stable in inner Sydney. The concept was to translate an existing 1990s office fitout into a modern residence, preserving the historic style of the building while inserting a brave and contemporary atmosphere inside. The project includes the addition of a modern carport with a landscaped roof terrace. The introduction of the impressive engineered double-height brick vault ceiling to the restructured rear wing is an appropriate element for the Italianate style of the house, referencing elements of historical grandeur that gave rise to the great architecture of early civilisations.

MELBOURNE ZOO PREDATOR PRECINCT PLEDGE WALL

OLA STUDIO

This project involved the challenge of designing a wall to mark the completion of the new Predator Precinct trail at Melbourne Zoo. Located beside a classic 1970s barbecue shelter in the zoo's northern picnic lawns, the undulating brick wall pays homage to the shelter in both form and materiality. The wall not only provides a climactic end to the precinct, but it also offers a new interpretation of the old structure. The wall's form references the pavilion's geometry. In elevation, a soft peak is centred on the structure's axis, while in plan the wall hugs the perimeter before peeling off and following the new precinct's pathway. The white hue of the selected brick allows reflected daylight to fill a previously dark space. It also complements and brings new life to the tones of the 1970s brick pavilion.

EDEN LANE

ROTHELOWMAN

A four-year staged development of four medium-rise apartment buildings has created a new laneway that follows the slope of the land, connecting established neighbourhoods and integrating new ones. The brief was to take the regularity of brick and make it reflective and playful. Flanked on both sides by apartments, an intuitively organic brick wall lets the landscape move with it. Upon exiting the garden, the wall enters the public space. A beautifully executed two-course-high brick seat willingly leaves the brickwork mass to simply float away and turn the corner. Bonding patterns move from a standard halfbond on flat walls, to the bricklayer's discretion on the three-dimensional curved sections. Brickwork is struck full and flush. A rough soldier pattern adds contrast behind the landscape elements and gives texture and a sense of warmth to the back of the seat. This brickwork is cultivated in its coarseness; there is no mortar to the vertical perpends, and bed joints are random. The repeated patterns and the depth of the vertical shadows draw softness out of the material.

GARDEN ROOM HOUSE

CLARE COUSINS ARCHITECTS

Garden Room House comprises an alteration and addition to a heritage home in Melbourne's Fitzroy North. The extension employs two shades of brick - a nod to the home's polychromatic brick frontage - to fluidly integrate internal and outdoor rooms to form an idyllic garden retreat in an urban context. A linear plan makes clever use of all available space on a site that slopes gradually down to the street. Level changes are addressed by the curated brick ground plane, which is stepped and terraced to form various resting places within the garden and living rooms, materially linking indoor and outdoor areas. The light-filled corridor running the length of the building borders the introduced garden room, which forms the breathing core of the home. When open, this area - complete with outdoor fireplace, dining area and partial shelter - extends available entertaining space and acts as a centralised lung to ventilate the house. Garden Room House's reconfigured smaller form and more efficient plan, coupled with a well-insulated building envelope, significantly reduce energy requirements in the home. The use of brick both inside and out will require little maintenance over the lifespan of this family's forever house.



Notions of home, safety and stability underlay the design of the front fence for the Explorers Early Learning Centre in Brighton East, Victoria. Ask a child to draw a house and they will often draw a box with a triangular roof and a chimney—their representation of a quintessential home. The design of this fence seeks to celebrate a sense of home and safety from a literal and yet whimsical representation of childlike houses. Just like in *The Three Little Pigs*, where it is the house of brick that prevails, in our suburbs the use of brick provides a similar sense of safety and stability. It was therefore an obvious choice that on a very busy road, this would be the most suitable material. But not just any brick—a brick that is earthy and warm in its tone, with a slight texture and mottled appearance that breathes life into the design.






















KEVIN BORLAND MASONRY AVADD

Tom Blachford

The Kevin Borland Masonry Award recognises projects that highlight the design potential of concrete masonry in commercial or residential built architecture.

Kevin Borland (1926-2000) was an innovative architect, a generous patron of younger architects, and an inspiring and much-loved design studio teacher.

After beginning his architectural studies at the University of Melbourne in 1944, Borland deferred to serve in the West Pacific in World War II. On returning, he completed his studies and graduated with a Bachelor of Architecture in 1950.

After working at Mockridge Stahle & Mitchell's office, Borland, together with friends Peter McIntyre and John and Phyllis Murphy, won the national competition to design the Melbourne swimming and diving stadium for the 1956 Summer Olympics.

Together with his former student and friend Daryl Jackson, Borland completed the design and construction of the distinguished brutalist Harold Holt Memorial Swimming Centre (1968-1969 in Melbourne's Glen Iris.

During a time when peer awards were far less common than they are today, Borland's designs received numerous awards from state chapters of the Royal Australian Institute of Architects. His work made a significant contribution to the trajectory of Melbourne architecture.

The Concrete Masonry Association of Australia (CMAA) is the peak body that represents the concrete masonry manufacturers of Australia. This includes bricks, blocks, pavers and retaining walls.

The CMAA supports the concrete masonry industry by providing technical information and advice to architects, engineers, specifiers and educators. The CMAA publishes technical manuals, data sheets and software packages relating to concrete block walling, concrete paving, permeable paving and concrete masonry retaining walls, which are free to download from the CMAA's website.

The Association also conducts workshop courses and provides a technical advisory service for masonry design queries.







HIGHBURY GROVE

RITZ&GHOUGASSIAN

Highbury Grove's framework seeks to articulate architecture as an enveloping medium, providing habitation to the user with an interiorised focus. Light and air are held in tension by the overlapping of architectural elements, creating a masonry shell. The shell is formed from a series of walls at ground level and a further series at 2.8 metres high. These defined masonry walls provide privacy to the northern laneway at street level and a series of apertures to the northern tree line that allow framed views outward. Space is defined within these parameters, held in balance as a series of architectural "moments" and views. The volume is light-filled and well ventilated. The volumes contained within the architectural envelope are separated by a series of breakout spaces that allow moments of pause between rooms and volumes. The masonry is run entirely in a stackbond configuration, both internally and externally, and held in suspension through the use of steel lintels.

KARDINYA CLOSE TASMANIA

HONED ARCHITECTURE + DESIGN

Kardinya Close is a beautiful home located on the Tamar River's edge in Tasmania. The clients are a retired American couple who share a love and passion for 1060s Californian architecture, especially the work of international architect Richard Neutra. During the concept design process they returned to California and met with Richard's son Dion to discuss the design. The concept design for this residence revolves around definitions of space. Each space throughout the home in framed and divided by stacked blockwork. The blade walls slice through the dwelling, from the external environment into the internal environment. The outcome is an amazing balance of layered textures, definitions of scale, proportion and the introduction of materiality. Polished Adbri Masonry blocks in Ivory were imported into Tasmania for the project. The blocks contribute significantly to the project as they set the "energy" of the home. They create the mood internally and externally, and they work to frame and divide, creating spatial awareness. Without this blockwork, the residence would not have such a unique grounding and stance within the landscape.

COLLINS STREET MELBOURNET & G


This project involves an extensive refurbishment of Melbourne's historic 1920s T&G Building, at the "Paris end" of Collins Street. The radical upgrade creates a holistic experience around premium retail and workspaces contained within the existing built fabric. The building is a symbol of Melbourne's rich heritage and an icon of the city skyline, and the renovation and modernisation of its ten storeys of commercial space creates a world-class office environment.

The lobby features a combination of Austral Masonry Architec bricks in Honed Alabaster and GB Split Face bricks. Forming part of an atrium masonry screen, 2,500 of the Architec bricks were laid horizontally and 11,800 GB Split Face bricks were laid vertically.

The refurbishment also includes the enhancement of the heritage-protected facade and the introduction of a dynamic new dual entrance, offering occupiers the option of using the original entry on Collins Street or the newly pedestrianised laneway, Ramsden Place, which connects to Flinders Lane.

The invigorated T&G Building showcases iconic design, adaptable workspaces, green credentials and innovative technology, and the precinct is set to become a model for the future of the Australian workplace.



THE ASH

DALECKI DESIGN

The Ash is a light, bright home with a mixed material palette and strong synergy between the indoor and outdoor living zones. The material palette incorporates feature brick and blockwork, both internally and externally, to add textural interest to the simple form of the house. Austral Bricks in Zinc have been used on the front facade, which seamlessly wraps through to the internal double-height feature wall at the core of the home. A protruding brick pattern fades up the wall, drawing the eye up toward the over-height ceiling and clerestory windows. As the northern light hits the wall through the windows, the protruding brickwork casts a shadow over the feature wall, enhancing the subtle pattern and shimmer in the brick. This brickwork carries through to feature walls in the living and alfresco zones to create cohesion between the internal and external spaces. Blockwork has been used as feature walls in the external zones, including the entry breezeblock wall, which diffuses light as it enters the dwelling, creating stunning shadow play.

WONWONDAH HOUSE

COOPER SCAIFE ARCHITECTS

This house is set in a stark landscape of harsh light, parched sandy soils and extreme summer heat. Unlike the sprawling vernacular of many rural Australian buildings, the design strategy here is one of containment within a tight, cube-like form. The house braces itself against the elements to provide refuge from what is, at times, an inhospitable environment. In this context, there is a strong emphasis on the use of robust materials and minimal detailing. Masonry, used for all external walls, was chosen for its durability, thermal performance and the textural qualities offered by split-face block. Although modest in scale, the design creates the sense that the house is larger than it really is, through the layering of internal spaces. The smooth masonry walls of the central stair act as a spatial divider between the open-plan living area and the kitchen. These walls run over both levels of the house and also serve to increase thermal mass. The slender grid of steel framing on the exterior has been designed to support large sunshades, protecting the most exposed elevations and expanding the living spaces into these shaded volumes.



THE BEEHIVE

RAFFAELLO ROSSELLI ARCHITECT WITH LUIGI ROSSELLI ARCHITECTS


Nestled between an industrial brick warehouse and a row of Victorian terrace houses, the Beehive refuses an immediate reading at first sight. Upon approach, the use of stacked terracotta roof tiles in the facade is revealed. reconfigured into a rhythmic brise-soleil. The project explores the perceived limitations of terracotta tiles and celebrates the layers of filigree and geometric complexity that can be found in the often-overlooked terracotta tile. The project started with the study of material waste streams for an appropriate object for a brise-soleil, to filter the harsh western sun that the main facade faces. The project utilises recycled materials, chosen from the start, rather than as an afterthought. The terracotta tile was chosen as it is a ubiquitous material without an established reuse market and it is readily available from demolition sites. Terracotta tiles are appealing for their raw, elemental materiality, with no two tiles exactly alike, as they are cast in clay and fired by hand. This project was a conscious attempt to re-contextualise the value of reusing materials, advocating for more sustainable solutions and showing clients and the wider public that it is possible to use waste products to dramatic effect.

BATHURST

MARPLE CONSTRUCTIONS

The re-roof and renovation of this builder's own home has transformed a ranch-style design into a Mediterranean-inspired villa. From the builder's perspective, the existing home had reached its architectural limits. As easy as it would have been to demolish and re-build it, the owner instead demonstrated passion and dedication by breathing life into this tired old home. He had been inspired by homes on Queensland's Sovereign Islands and set about creating his own villa in the peaceful country setting of Bathurst, in New South Wales.

The new work features Curvado roof tiles in the colour Galia. This colour is a mix of cream and orange tones with splashes of dirty white. The use of the rounded clay tiles coupled with a vibrant colour palette creates an eyecatching home in a sea of washed-out metal roofs. With the guidance of a master tiler, the roof was stripped bare and rebuilt to ensure a roof free of visual and structural imperfections. The result is a beautiful home with subtle yet distinctive Mediterranean features.




PARISH OF SAINTS RAPHAEL, NICHOLAS AND IRENE CHURCH

LOUCAS ZAHOS ARCHITECTS

This church has a classic Mediterranean appeal that could be found on a Greek island. The use of whitewashed walls combined with Curvado and Medio Curva natural terracotta tiles from Bristile Roofing sets this church apart from others in South Australia. The star of the show is the main dome, weighing more than twelve tonne and requiring sixty hours of on-site consultation and almost a thousand man-hours to tile. The dome consists of three thousand Medio Curva tiles, with more than two thousand being individually cut and shaped and all containing screws, top and bottom, and glued to ensure no movement while the crane lifted the dome into place. As the dome was to be lined with Gyprock and hand painted, waterproofing was paramount. This required the dome to be lined with two layers each of marine ply and fibreglass, and one layer of galvanised sheeting. The rear of the church features three smaller domes that were clad in a similar process. The front of the church has two turrets clad in Curvado tiles, blending in with the main roof, and five smaller gables over external doorways.



LEWISHAM ROAD HOUSE

CLARE COUSINS ARCHITECTS

Lewisham Road House – one half of a pair of pre-war semidetached houses – is located on a small inner-city block. The project called for a sympathetic yet hardworking addition to the retained front room of the original house. Clad in terracotta shingles, the new volume draws inspiration from the prominent existing roof and responds sensitively to the adjacent house and broader streetscape. The notion of a traditional terracotta roof is questioned, with the existing roof wrapping up to sheathe the new form's walls with tiles. The terracotta walls are punctured by black steel-framed openings, allowing views to the parkland beyond and intimate framed views to the garden. A delicate steel fin demarcates the threshold between old and new spaces, while the tiles have been mitred at the volume's corners to create crisp, articulated edges.
